**INVITATION TO COVER THE PRESS CONFERENCE OF AYC EXECUTIVE  
CHAIRPERSON IN UGANDA**

**WHAT:** Ms. Natalie Sonia Mukundane, Executive Chairperson of the African Youth Commission (AYC) will make her first official visit to the Republic of Uganda from 13-17 May, 2019.

Ugandan young lawyer and seasoned youth advocate Ms. Mukundane elected the first female Executive Chairperson of the AYC on 26<sup>th</sup> March 2019 in Banjul.

During the visit to her country, Chairperson will meet with youth leaders, representatives of youth and civil society organisations, high-level government officials, the UN System and other key partners to present the AYC National Consortium, identify potential areas of cooperation and discuss modalities of support for the implementation of the AYC Strategic Plan 2018-2020, which outlines practical steps to create decent job and entrepreneurship opportunities for young people, improve health services including comprehensive sexuality education in formal and non-formal education, promote human rights and deliver good governance, accountability and social cohesion at all levels as well as encourage inclusion and active participation of youth in the maintenance of peace and security in the country, at regional and continental levels.
